NOTICE

The County of Orange conducts strict enforcement of the following County Ordinances and State Statues. This enforcement will continue on an ongoing basis.

OCCO Sec 2-5-95. Camping; use of camp paraphernalia; storage of personal property; permit required;

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to camp, use camp paraphernalia, or store personal property upon any lands or easements owned or managed the County of Orange except pursuant to a valid County permit issued by the Director or his/her agents.

CPC 647. Every person who commits any of the following acts is guilty of disorderly conduct, a misdemeanor:

(j) Who lodges in any building, structure, vehicle, or place, whether public or private, without the permission of the owner or person entitled to the possession or in control of it.

OCCO Sec. 2-5-43. Bicycles.

(a) *Bicycle Parking.* No person shall leave a bicycle on a road or trail in a park, beach or recreational area in such a way to obstruct pedestrian, equestrian, or vehicle traffic. Any person convicted of violating this subsection shall be guilty of an infraction.

OCCO Sec. 4-13-52. Litter control.

No person shall discard any waste material including but not limited to common household rubbish or garbage of any kind (whether generated or accumulated at a residence, business or other location), upon any public property, whether occupied, open or vacant, including but not limited to any street, sidewalk, alley, right-of-way, open area or point of entry to the storm water drainage system.

CPC 22435.2. It is unlawful to do any of the following acts, if a shopping cart has a permanently affixed sign.

(f) To be in possession of any shopping cart while that cart is not located on the premises or parking lot of a retail establishment.
