(1) This report provides an unduplicated count of students involved in one or more incidents during the academic year who were subsequently suspended or expelled from school. For the purposes of calculating suspensions and expulsion rates in this report, students who were suspended or expelled multiple times are counted only once in the report totals for these respective disciplinary outcome categories.

(2) The rate of suspensions and expulsions is calculated by dividing the total number of incidents by the total enrollment and multiplying by 100.

(3) The "Cumulative Enrollment" count provides the total number of unique or unduplicated primary, secondary, and short-term enrollments within the academic year (July 1 to June 30), regardless of whether the student is enrolled multiple times within a school or district.

(4) The "Census Enrollment" count provides the total unique or unduplicated number of primary enrollments on the CALPADS Fall 1 Census Day, which is the first Wednesday in October of the associated academic year.
