) PURSUANT TO STIPULATION

19 The parties having stipulated thereto, and good cause having been shown, it is ORDERED,  
20 ADJUDGED, and DECREED as follows:


- 21 1. Nothing herein constitutes an admission by either party of any wrongdoing.
- 22 2. For good cause under Election Code §16000 *et seq.*, defendant Roman Reyna's position as  
23 a member of the Santa Ana City Council, representing Ward 4, shall terminate at 12 noon, March 1,  
24 2019. Reyna shall not seek appointment to the vacancy created by his termination nor accept any  
25 appointment to the vacancy, and he shall not run in any special election called to fill the vacancy. He  
26 shall not serve as a councilman during the current term of Ward 4. Nothing herein prevents Reyna  
27 from running for any other office in the City of Santa Ana, or to seek election to Ward 4 in 2022.
- 28 3. The court shall retain jurisdiction under Code of Civil Procedure §664.6 to enforce this

1 settlement until performance in full of the terms of the settlement. This includes the right of the  
2 contestant or any other elector of the city of Santa Ana to seek enforcement of this settlement if  
3 Reyna acts contrary to the provisions in Paragraph 2 of this agreement.

4 4. Maria Huizar shall be dismissed without prejudice, as she is no longer the city clerk of the  
5 City of Santa Ana. Should the current city clerk or any other person or body at the city of Santa Ana  
6 be necessary for the enforcement of this stipulation, the statement of contest and the judgment can be  
7 amended to add such persons or bodies as parties for the purpose of enforcing the judgment.

8 5. The parties shall each bear their own attorneys fees and costs. Should any person need to  
9 enforce this settlement under Paragraph 3 of this agreement, the prevailing party in any such  
10 enforcement effort shall be entitled to attorneys fees and costs from the other party.
