Motions for 4C-1

4 new maps: (1) 4C-1 with Do changes, (2) 4C-1 with Do, Bartlett changes; (3) 4C-1 with Do, Bartlett, Foley changes; (4) 4C-1 with Do, Foley changes.

Do Changes to 4C-1

- (1) move 26 residents in Santa Ana from D1 to D2;
- (2) move 622 residents in Newport Beach from D1 to D5;
- (3) move 738 residents in Yorba Linda from D4 to D3;
- (4) move 7 residents in Costa Mesa from D5 to D1;
- (5) move 1437 residents of Laguna Beach from D3 to D5; and
- (6) move 1960 residents of Placentia from D3 to D4.

Bartlett Changes to 4C-1

- Aliso Viejo to D5 from D3
- Laguna Hills to D3 from D5
- RMV CDP to D5 from D3
- Ladera Ranch CDP to D5 from D3
- Move Irvine North of the 5 from D5 to D3

Foley Changes to 4C-1

- Swap HB into D1 from D5 and Costa Mesa into D5 from D1
- Move Irvine North of the 5 from D5 to D3 to accommodate and balance of swap of HB into D1 from D5 and Costa Mesa into D5 from D1

No changes to 5A-1, advanced to Monday November 22.
