Project Name: Stanton Inn & Suites

City: Stanton

Number of units: 72

Status: Interim operations started November 25, 2020 and ended in September 2022. The site is currently undergoing rolling rehabilitation of units to convert into permanent supportive housing.

Project Name: Tahiti

City: Stanton

Number of units: 60

Status: Interim operations started March 2021 and ended in September 2022. The site is currently in undergoing rolling rehabilitation of units to convert into permanent supportive housing.

Project Name: Riviera Motel

City: Stanton

Number of units: 20 Units

Status: This site is currently in construction/rehabilitation to convert into permanent supportive housing.

Project Name: Huntington Beach Oasis

City: Huntington Beach

Number of units: 62

Status: Interim operations began October 2022. This site will convert to permanent housing at a later date, the timeline has yet to be confirmed.

Project Name: Motel 6

City: Costa Mesa

Number of units: 88

Status: This site is finalizing closing escrow and related documents. Construction has not started yet at this site.

Project Name: Studio 6

City: Anaheim

Number of units: 89

Status: Interim operations began October 2022. This site will convert to permanent housing at a later date, the timeline has yet to be confirmed.”
