Dear Ms. Monda,

The City of Laguna Beach ("City") received and reviewed your request under the California Public Records Act ("CPRA"). (Gov. Code §§ 6250, et seq.) The City received your CPRA request on November 18, 2022. The City thereafter notified you that it required an additional 14 days to respond to your request. This correspondence will serve as the City's response to your CPRA request.

Your CPRA request seeks the following categories of records:

1. Disclosure of all body-worn camera footage from Officer Matt Gregg on November 16, 2022;
2. Disclosure of all call logs, radio transmissions, and dispatch radio transmissions involving Officer Matt Gregg on November 16, 2022; and
3. The number of police officers who have left Laguna Beach PD since June 2021.

Under the CPRA, the City is required to make certain public records available for your inspection or to permit you to obtain copies, unless the records are subject to an exemption.

Pursuant to Government Code section 6254 subdivision (f), records of a law enforcement investigation are generally exempt from disclosure. The City has determined that it is in possession of records that are responsive to categories (1) and (2). However, the City has determined that the responsive records are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Government Code section 6254 subdivision (f). Accordingly, the City will not be providing any records in response to those categories.

As for category (3), the City is not in possession of a responsive record and is not under an obligation to create a record. Nonetheless, the City is providing you with the number of police officers who have left Laguna Beach PD since June 2021: one Police Officer did not pass probation; three Police Officers have retired from the City of Laguna Beach; and, seven Police Officers have left for additional pay, benefits or career opportunities at the City of Irvine, San Diego Harbor Patrol, OC Sheriff Dept, OC District Attorney's Office and Riverside County District Attorney's Office.
